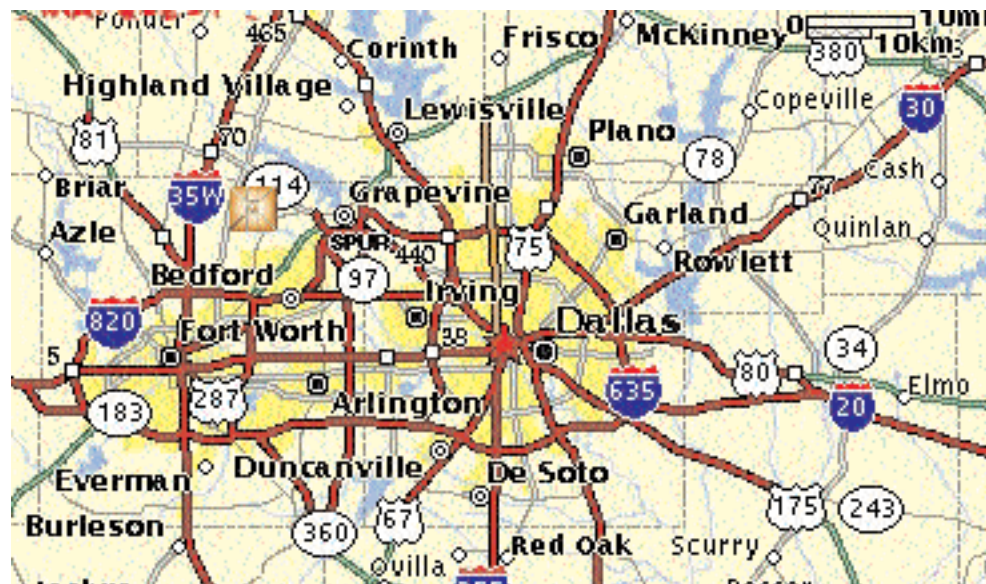

Art In The Square

April 23rd 4 p.m. - 9 p.m.

Entertainment will continue until 10 pm on Friday and Saturday night.

All artwork must be original. No prefabricated forms, kits, imports, manufactured molds, wholesale or mass-produced items.

Artwork must be produced by the artist

The Artist must be present.

Reproductions are acceptable but a significant amount of original work must be displayed.

All artwork will be juried by a panel which includes professional artists, gallery owners as well as community members.

To insure fairness for every artist, the rules contained in the application will be strictly enforced.

Art In The Square is open to all artists 18 years and older.

1. All nudes must be prejuried.
2. If two or more persons collaborate on a booth both names must be on the application. Slides must be presented by each artist.
3. Ceramics must be handmade by the artist. If multiple pieces of the original design are displayed, they each must be numbered.
4. Artist provides own tent (white or cream) and display which must be safe and sturdy. Southlake can be very windy so tents must be able to be secured with stakes or weights. Tables must be covered to the ground. All boxes and supplies must be neatly covered.
5. Security will be provided, however no one connected with the Art Fair is responsible for damage or loss to your property.
6. No sale or discount signs. No soliciting political or religious materials or imposing those views on customers or fellow artists.
7. Electricity is available and free but limited to 300 watts per space.
